HOUSEKEEPING

No matter what your occupation
Good housekeeping is important
Keeping workplace neat and tidy
can prevent injuries
Even fatalities

HOUSEKEEPING

An orderly worksite can help prevent:

- **Injury resulting from a fall**
- **Injury after being struck by an object**
- **Death in a fire caused by improper storage**
- **Reduced productivity caused by clutter**

Good housekeeping doesn't just happen

- It requires teamwork and guidelines
- Workers should help set standards

HOUSEKEEPING

Sometimes rules come after close calls

Suddenly cleanup seems more important

Don't wait to shape up

Make it a priority now

Use checklists and standads

Follow recommended practices

Keep areas free of clutter

Keep floors clean and dry

Vacuum and sweep frequently

HOUSEKEEPING

Store materials in designated areas

Clearly label all containers

Use proper waste containers

Keep sprinklers, fire alarms and extinguishers clear

Clean up all spills properly and promptly

Remember to store tools in their place

Report or repair damaged tools and equipment

Or remove from service until fixed properly

Watch for overloaded electrical circuits

Follow maintenance requirements
