  - There was one question.
    - Question: Once a space is reclassified as non-permit, how long is that reclassification good?
    - Answer: The reclassification is good as long as the form dictates. In addition to the form, there should be no hazardous condition or reasonable potential for the occurrence of a hazardous condition, including actual or potential atmospheric hazards. Therefore, the space must be continually evaluated to maintain the reclassified status. Bottom line, consult your cognizant safety office to support confined space entries, permits, reclassifications and rescues.
