  - Made contractors aware of the increased penalties for driving while using a mobile communication device.
- Questions and answer session.
  - There were two questions.
    1. Question: What shall a supervisor do if an employee is seen generating dust? More specifically, should the employee be told to wear a dust mask?  
Answer: Under the voluntary respirator use policy, employees shall not be instructed to wear a dust mask. If employees are instructed to wear dust masks, the employer must have and comply with a written respiratory protection program. The best thing to do is assist the employee with engineering out the dust (i.e. cut concrete wet to eliminate dust).
    2. Question: What shall a person do if they receive an important telephone call while driving on Stennis Space Center?  
Answer: Find a safe location to pull off the road, turn on hazard lights, place the vehicle in park and answer the telephone call.
