Construction Safety Findings: 3-7 March 2008

- Findings Total: 8
 - Major Findings: 1
 - Walking Working Surface: 1
 - Unprotected opening. (elevator doors left open and unprotected)
 - Minor Findings: 7
 - Damaged extension cords found on construction site.
 - Electrical: 2
 - Missing cover plate on energized receptacles.
 - Work Practices: 3
 - 2 findings of Working from the top step of a ladder.
 - Ladder being used to access roof hatch did not extend 3 feet above landing and was not secure.
 - Scaffolds: 1
 - Wheels not locked on mobile scaffold while in use.
 - Housekeeping: 1
 - Housekeeping issues around trailer area. Nails not removed from used lumber on site.
 - Mishaps: 0 / Close Calls: 1: Roofer doing flashing work on building 8100 fume hoods without proper PPE.

Construction Safety Findings: 10-14 March 2008

- Findings Total: 7
 - Major Findings: 1
 - Fall Protection: 1
 - Employee not using fall protection while installing flashing on roof.
 - Minor Findings: 6
 - Fall Protection: 1
 - Employee not inspecting fall protection prior to the start of work. (system was not set up correctly, (missing weights on PR-600)
 - Electrical: 2
 - 2 Damaged extension cord found on site. (one on tile cutting machine).
 - Material Handling : 1
 - Unattended piece of equipment (backhoe) left running.
 - Work Practice:1
 - Evidence of smoking around flammables. (no smoking sign posted)
 - IH Issues: 2
 - Contractor did not have a change out schedule for respirator cartridge replacement
 - Breathing air compressor carbon monoxide monitoring was insufficient. (no CO2 alarm and no sampling per shift) (last sampled was 2/26/08)
 - Mishaps: 2 / Close Calls: 1: Electrician doing work on building 8100 near fume hoods without checking with Building Manager.
 - Contractor drilling into concrete hit a telecommunications line for security cameras for the building.
 - Fire on third floor construction area, Cause unknown, under Investigation, Mishap board formed

Construction Safety Findings: 17-21 March 2008

- Findings Total: 9
 - Major Findings: 0Minor Findings: 9
 - PPE: 3
 - 2 employees not wearing eye protection. One employee was drilling metal and one employee was pouring concrete.
 - Employee working on construction site without hard hat protection.
 - Fire Protection: 1
 - Unserviceable fire extinguisher found (discharged) near metal chop-saw operation.
 - Material Handling : 1
 - Employee operating RT forklift. No documentation could be produced to prove training.
 - Trenching and Excavation: 2
 - Spoil pile was not at least two feet away from the top of the excavation with employees present.
 - Excavation was not barricaded and no employees present.
 - Housekeeping: 1
 - Scrap material on third floor creating housekeeping issue.
 - Work Practices: 1
 - Lighting is inadequate in some work areas of third floor.
 - Mishaps: 0 / Close Calls: 1: Employee in confined space, not following procedures.
 - Building 1100 roof: Cafeteria worker went to the clinic with dust in eye. Said roofing dust was cause.

Construction Safety Findings: 24-28 March 2008

- Findings Total: 5
 - Major Findings: 0
 - Minor Findings: 5
 - Work Practice: 3
 - Employee working alone. Unaware of emergency contact information. Information not posted.
 - Dig Permit issued for work but form was not complete. Missing operators signature and supervisor signature.
 - Employee working from the top step of a ladder.
 - Electrical: 2
 - Damaged power cord found on tile cutting machine on jobsite.
 - Tools being used, not connected to a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI).
 - Mishaps: 0 / Close Calls: 0:
