



Everyone's A Safety Inspector

Hazards lurk out of sight and out of mind

Until something serous happens

Assign many people to look for them

Safety inspection is part of your job

Inspection program includes:

- Managers
- Supervisors
- Safety committee members
- Employees
- Contractors
- Subcontractors

Inspect:

Vehicles and equipment

General sites

- Field and office locations
- Maintenance shops
- Work camps
- Company leisure areas

Site inspections include:

- Physical layout and conditions
- Hazards of materials handled
- Condition of equipment and tools
- Work practices and behavior of people at the site
- Level and quality of supervision

Examples of hazards:

- Slipping and tripping
- Dangerous gases
- Faulty or missing emergency equipment
- Improper or missing signs
- Faulty machinery, cables and securing devices

More hazards to look for:

- Faulty electrical equipment and connections
- Confined spaces
- Blocked exits
- Difficult terrain for vehicle or worker movement
- Flammable, corrosive or explosive materials
- Missing material safety data sheets
