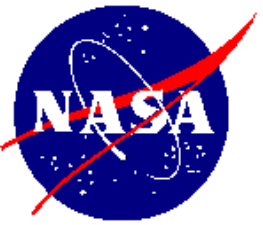

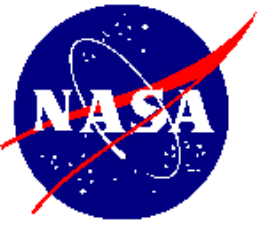

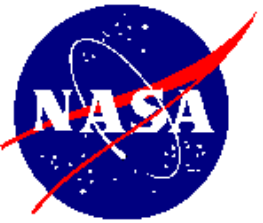

- **HPG:** While performing safety inspections on the Cross Country High Pressure Gas project at the E-Complex, the Construction Manager discovered that the contractor had completed two road crossing trenches, but only had one dig permit and one line drawing attached. The contractor had assumed that one dig permit authorized both road crossings. Immediately the contractor performed a safety stand-down to train construction personnel on the requirements for dig area line drawings and dig area permit approvals. Ref: SSTD-8070-0119-MISC “Dig Permit Standard” Section 5.1.5.f. SHEtrak finding closed and training record attached. .

# Approved Dig Permit Area



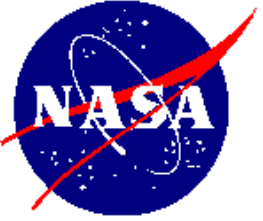

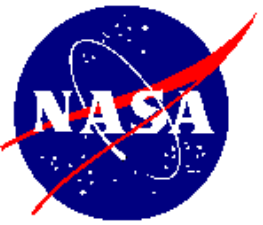

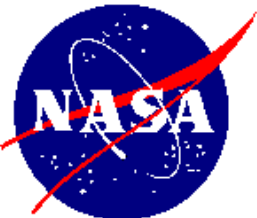
