- <u>Natural Gas System Modification</u>: Two separate cylinder gauges had visible signs of damage i.e.(Bent damaged internal components and missing gauge protective face covers). Both gauge units were connected to separate connections. Ref: 29CFR1926.350 (h)
- <u>Natural Gas System Modification</u>: Contractor was using an extension cord with a missing ground pin on the plug end.
 Ref: 29CFR1926.404 (b)(1)(iii)(C)
- <u>Natural Gas System Modification</u>: Contractor failed to properly secure two gas oxygen cylinders in an upright position at all times. Ref: 29CFR1926.350 (a) (9)
- <u>Natural Gas System Modification</u>: Contractor failed to wear hearing protection when using a power grinder to surface pipe ends. Ref: 29CFR1926.101 (a)


Mishaps: 0 / Close Calls: 1








Construction Humor :
