 - Presented four core VPP elements.
 - Discussed DART and TCIR rates for SSC and stated that construction leads the site.
- Questions and answer session.
 - One contractor requested clarification on who is required to provide the red locks for LOTO. It was answered that each contractor is responsible for providing their employees with the locks. SSC will provide the tags.
 - One contractor wanted to know why each site is required to have at least one person First Aid\CPR qualified if we have a Fire Department on site. It was answered that the Fire Department alone does not satisfy the OSHA requirement if there is not a clinic readily accessible. SSC does have a clinic but it is only open during normal business hours. Several contractors start work early or work late and on weekends, while the clinic is closed. So, they are required to have at least one person trained in First Aid\CPR on site.
