 - Solicited all attendees for input on ways to possibly improve the monthly meetings or any other facet of the construction safety program with the intent of making the program more meaningful.
 - Reminded attendees of the NASA Close Call Reporting System and the importance of recognizing a close call or near miss as a warning sign that a mishap may occur. Stressed the importance of documentation of those close calls and immediate correction of the potential hazards.
- Keith Pierce (Deputy Manger, NASA Safety)
 - Spoke about placing a higher standard on safety related past performance when it comes to the selection process of future contractors. Stressed that a poor past performance may affect a contractor's ability to get future jobs at SSC.
 - Alerted all to the fact that SSC currently leads the entire agency in mishaps and reiterated that everyone must make an extra effort to work safely.
