Importance: High

- It has been confirmed with NASA security that there have been several recent cougar sightings on Stennis. I was told the sightings have been in the vicinity of the canal spillway and south easement.
- BE ALERT!
- All employees should be alert when in the vicinity of wooded areas of the test site, including the Cypress House area.
- Joggers, hikers, and bikers should be especially alert. I highly recommend limiting those activities to the populated areas of Stennis, and not doing them alone.
- Personnel entering or leaving our facilities in the dark should WALK WITH PURPOSE and get inside as quickly as possible. Dawn, dusk and night smokers are advised to stay close to the building/door.
